

## MURRSKO SREDIŠĆE

In Peklenica, near the Brodec stream in Mursko Središće, a memorial park of oil extraction has been created next to the living oil spring. In the park three-legged oil wells oil carts have been placed that were used to transport the oil to the Mursko Središće railway station. Interesting fact that the oil wells are still filled with crude oil.

Information boards show the visitors the history of oil extraction in Peklenica and oil industry in the area of Mursko Središće. The park offers entertainment for all ages, where a playground has also been created.

## THE ENERGY CONNECTS— across borders and beyond





Special investments have been made in the Hungarian-Croatian-Slovenian tri-border area, including the Lenti microregion. The project „Traditional, energy-industrial joint tourism development on the Hungarian and Croatian sides of the triple border (ENERGY TOUR)” within the Interreg V-A Hungary-Croatia Cooperation Programme, with the coordination of the Municipality of Lovászi as lead partner, significant developments have been carried out in the area of Lenti and in the town of Mursko Središće, in the neighbouring Croatia. The common feature of the various investments is that all project elements are related to energy.

## LOVÁSZI

The air shelter bunker in the middle of Lovászi, built from the beginning to the middle of the 20th century, is a unique facility in the country. Aim of the project element was to create a unique interactive exhibition on the origin of the oil, and the operation of the settlement and the air-raid shelter during the Cold War, and the local aspects of the events of 1956. The visual and sound effects will give the visitors an insight into the operation of the emergency protocol, providing a unique experience. Upon completion of the project part of the air shelter bunker renovated by the project will be made available for visitors in form of guided tours.



## LENTI

In Lentiszombathely, in the former school building, an alternative demonstration centre has been set up, where visitors can learn about the modern use of renewable energy sources. In addition to solar and wind energy demonstrations, there is also a solar-powered rest area set up.



## GOSZTOLA

In Gosztola, a jewel box hidden in the Zala hills, an oil rig has been installed and information boards have been placed to provide detailed information on energy-related (oil and other) tourism attractions. The boards include a map of the Energy Tour thematic route, highlighting the nearby attractions. Information boards are located at: Gosztola centre, Gosztola oil rig, Bakarend, Lendvadedes belfry, Lendvadedes lake.
